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**JOB GOALS:**

To establish a golf program that will interest students and provide a general knowledge of, and improvement of skills at, the sport. To provide a program that will encourage carry over value to all students.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS** include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

1. Have a call out in February or March to ascertain the number of students interested in the sport.
2. In conjunction with the Athletic Director, provide a competitive schedule.
3. Supervise and direct all practice sessions and home golf matches.
4. In conjunction with the Athletic Director, contact the golf course (at the present time, Plymouth Country club), and set up practice schedules and home golf matches.
5. Be responsible for transportation to all away golf matches.
6. Be responsible for establishing the order of players who participate in golf matches.
7. Be responsible for the actions of all participants of the team, and provide any discipline that is necessary for violation of any rules or of the established etiquette of golf.
8. Keep all records of all golf matches. At the end of the year this summary should be given to the Athletic Director's Office.
9. Be responsible for the inventory of any equipment, if necessary.
10. Be responsible for the awarding of all awards at the end of the season.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

**EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE:**

Certified teacher and employment with the Plymouth community School Corporation if required by the IHSAA; or related experience and/or training.

**CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS:**

Valid state driver's license - operator permit

**LANGUAGE SKILLS:**

Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals. Ability to write routine reports and correspondence. Ability to speak effectively before groups of athletes, school officials, parents, and the press.

**MATHEMATICAL SKILL:**

Ability to work with mathematical concepts. Ability to apply concepts such as fractions, percentages, ratios, and proportions to practical situations.

**REASONING ABILITY:**

Ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of concrete variables in situations where only limited standardization exists. Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS:**

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to talk and hear. The employee frequently is required to stand; walk; sit; use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls; reach with hands and arms; and taste or smell.

The employee must be physically able to demonstrate the sport or activity, including lifting all equipment as required by the activity. This is to include games and practice.

The employee must have the physical stamina to be able to handle the hours and physical stress of the sport during contests and practices.

Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

The employee should be able to use the machines, tools, equipment, and work aids which may be representative of those commonly associated with this type of work.
